## Information for persons who could access compensation payments for lost income

## What you need to know:

- The main informations is available on the Geneva canton website, at the address:

- You can only access compensation payment if you have resided (with or without a permit) in Geneva at least since 17 March 2019;
- You can access compensation payment if you have been working since at least 17 December 2019, declared or undeclared, documented or undocumented;
- The payment will compensate income lost between 17 Mars 2020 and 16 May 2020, because of the coronavirus crisis;
- Compensation payment is only available to persons who have not reveived other forms of public financial compensation (unemployment benefits, social benefits, coronavirus-specific compensation funds) for the income lost between 17 March and 16 May 2020;
- Compensation payments can be requested online on the Geneva canton website as of 19 September 2020 and for the following 90 days, if there is no referendum against the law;
- As of 19 September, associations and trade unions listed below will be available to help you fill in the request if needed;
- Beware of persons asking for money to help you file a request;
- Public information sessions about this law and how to file a request will be organized by associations and trade unions between 31 August and 18 September 2020. Infomation about these sessions will follow and be communicated broadly.
